Roll call/Inspection: AM roll call will be at 8:30 am. Running starts 9:30am (Eastern Time zone).

Dogs belonging to trial workers may be inspected early. An inspection committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the field committee will measure small dogs, inspect each entry for lameness, fitness to compete and females in season. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or a female in season shall not be allowed to compete and entry fees shall be refunded.

Running order:

Dogs running 300 yard course followed by dogs running the 600 yard course.

- 300 Yard Course. This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and / or brachycephalic (“flat-faced”) dogs. A dog must complete this course in less than 1 ½ minutes.
- 600 Yard Course. This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. A dog must complete this course in less than 2 minutes.

If there is a question regarding which course a dog should run, the judge will decide.

The Coursing Ability Test is a pass – fail event. In order to pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time for the course length. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog’s performance. **A dog that relieves itself on course shall fail the test.** Ribbons will be awarded to dogs that pass.

Shorter Distance for Veteran Dogs: Veteran dogs may be allowed to run two-thirds of the normal distance at the handler’s discretion. For the purpose of CAT tests, veteran dogs are defined as dogs over 7 years of age. The handler must declare prior to the start of the dog’s run which distance the dog will run. This means that a veteran dog which would normally run the 300 yard course may run 200 yards and a veteran dog which would normally run the 600 yard course may run 400 yards. Time to complete the course remains the same.

Eligibility: Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Please do not bring in-season bitches to these tests, just report the bitch as in-season to the trial secretary.

Collars/Paraphernalia. No retractable-type leads, please. Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. Owners should be aware that there is a chance that tags hanging from the collar could become entangled on something during the run. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog’s hair. The owner assumes full responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog’s collar and paraphernalia on the dog.

NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED WITHIN 50 feet of the course or equipment.

The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips and will run on a battery-powered continuous loop system. Back-up equipment will be available.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any dog that is loose on the field and/or not in competition with the course in progress.

There will be a \$5.00 fee assessed to anyone who fails to pick-up after their hound. It is important that the trial site be kept free of debris, trash and feces.

Bring your own shade and water.

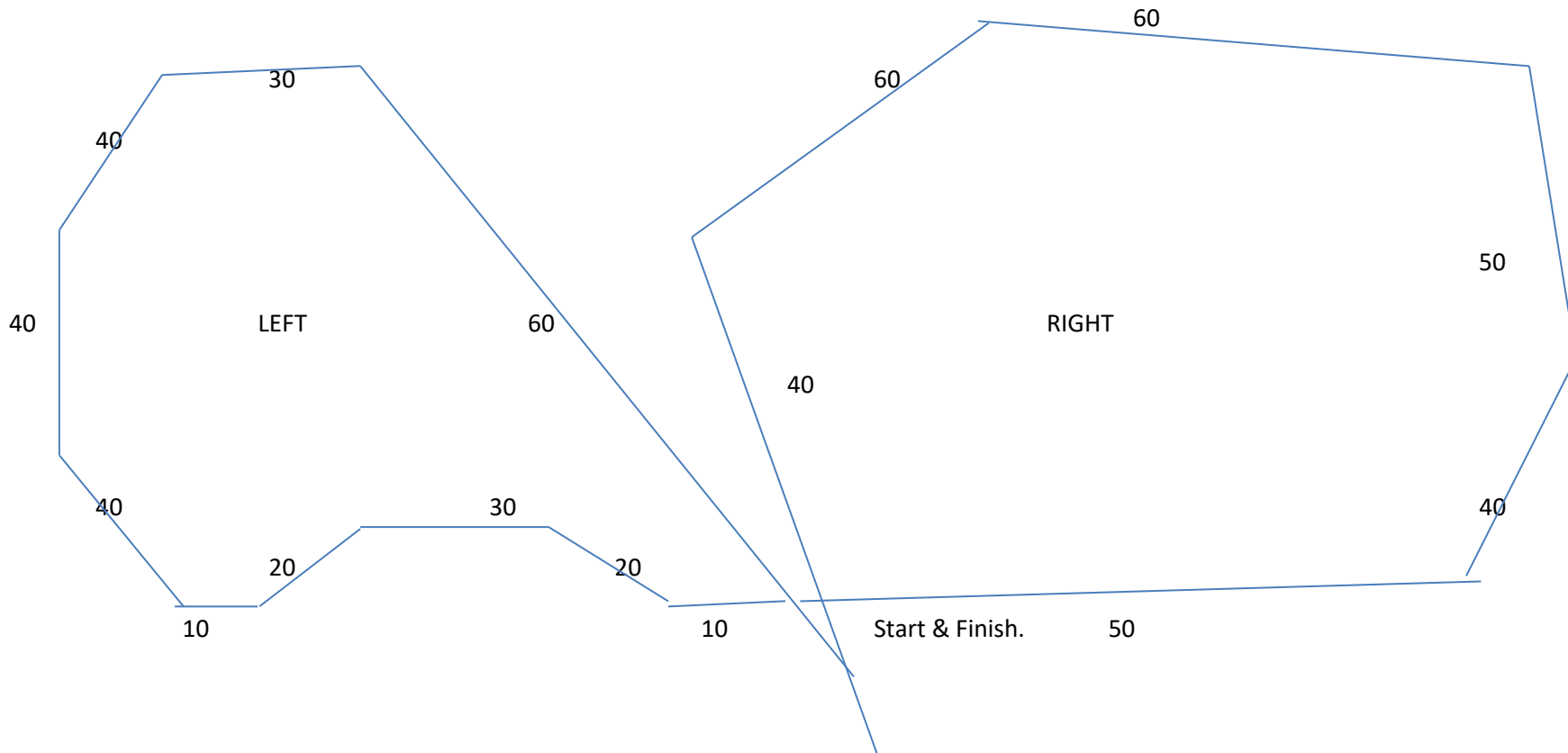
Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined AKC.

COURSE PLANS:

ILCC reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

Saturday and Sunday (300 yds.). Dogs running 300 yards will run either the left or the right side of the course only. For example, if the first dog to run is assigned the left side of the course, the second dog will run the right side. This alternating pattern will continue for all dogs running the 300 yard course.

Saturday and Sunday (600 yds.). The entire course (left and right sides) will be used.
