Dogs belonging to trial workers may be inspected early. An inspection committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the field committee. Each entry will be inspected breed disqualifications, lameness, fitness to compete and females in season. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded.

Running order will be posted after roll call: The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the testing Hound for the qualifying course.

Ribbons will be awarded to dogs that pass.

Eligibility: Sighthounds. Tests are pass/fail events. Dogs must be at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

BREED DISQUALIFICATIONS. Hounds with breed disqualifications, as listed in the AKC Breed Standards, are ineligible to enter lure coursing trials and tests.

NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED WITHIN 50 feet of the course or equipment.

NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED ON THE RUNNING FIELD.

The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips and will run on a battery-powered continuous loop system. Back-up equipment will be available.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any dog that is loose on the field and/or not in competition with the course in progress.

There will be a \$5.00 fee assessed to anyone who fails to pick-up after their hound. It is important that the trial site be kept free of debris, trash and feces.

Bring your own shade and water.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined AKC.

Directions to field:

FROM I-70: Take I-70 to exit 96 (Mt. Comfort Rd. exit). Go south on N County Road 600 W approximately 2.9 miles to US-40. Turn right (west) and go approximately 3 miles to S. German Church Rd. Turn right (south) onto German Church Rd. and go 1.3 miles to Prospect. The field is on the left at the corner of S. German Church road and Prospect Street. Field Trial sign will be posted.

FROM I-74: Take I-74 to exit 96 (Post Rd. exit). Go north on Post Road approximately 2 miles to US-42/Brookville Rd. Turn right (east) and go approximately 2.1 miles to S. German Church Rd. Turn left (north) onto German Church Rd. and go 1.3 miles to Prospect St. The field is on the right at the corner of S. German Church road and Prospect Street. Field Trial sign will be posted.

FROM I-465: Take I-465 to exit 47 (on the southeast side of Indianapolis). Go right onto US-52/ Brookville Road. Go east on US-52 approximately 3.4 miles to S. German Church Rd. Turn left (north) on German Church Rd. and go 1.3 miles to Prospect St. The field is on the right at the corner of S. German Church road and Prospect Street.
